




Seventeen-year-old Gene Klein and fourteen-year-old Stanley Eisen each envisioned strutting across the stage at Madison Square Garden. They didn't know each other, yet dreamed the same dream only two miles apart. Eventually they met, set their sights, and soon became Gene Simmons and Paul Stanley. Today, they have earned the right to be recognized as leaders of one of the world's most influential and recognizable rock 'n roll bands in history!

Paul's first encounter with Gene was truly a coincidence. Gene's guitarist in his college band Bullfrog Bheer ran off with a girl just before a weekend gig. Gene headed into NYC to see his friend Steve Coronel, looking for a replacement. Paul happened to be playing in a band with Steve, and was introduced to Gene at Coronel's apartment as Steve's other songwriting friend. Gene shoved a guitar into Paul's hands and asked him to play one of his songs. Paul played and Gene was both impressed and angry he'd lost the challenge. Despite multiple encounters that went awry, Gene and Paul managed to put their egos aside and formed Wicked Lester. Even after signing with Epic Records, it was apparent Wicked Lester was not the deadly rock 'n roll assault squad Gene and Paul had wanted.

Songs they had written - 'Deuce,' 'Firehouse,' and 'Black Diamond' - were more honed and had a distinct personality separate from Wicked Lester. Gene and Paul knew they had to explore. They disassociated themselves from the band, secretly at first, by continuing to practice a few nights a week, while auditioning lead guitarists and drummers on the side. After hearing numerous musicians, they met Peter Crisscoula and Paul Frehley. Instinctively, they knew these two would compliment and complete the dynamic energy they wanted. The band formed and continued to evolve their costumes and make-up. Toward the end of 1972, they became KISS - Gene Simmons (Demon) on bass

and vocals, Paul Stanley (Starchild) on guitar and vocals, Peter Criss (Catman) on drums and vocals and Ace Frehley (Spaceman) on guitar.

Their concerts became, and continue to be known as legendary – with dizzying arrays of lights, explosions, smoke and fire. KISS sold out concerts throughout its reign and continues to do so during its 2000 "Farewell" Tour, twenty-eight years after the band's formation.

Bands dream of the longevity and success KISS has attained, which remain a testament to Gene and Paul's genius and creativity. Their costumes and stage personas are world-renowned, with the band's images featured on everything from this catalogue, to t-shirts and tatoos, action figures to comic books and cartoons. Gene and Paul indeed reached their goal of establishing a musical collaboration that has changed the face of rock 'n roll.

We are pleased to offer at auction artifacts, which include costumes, guitars, drum sets, stage designs, contracts, lyrics, sketches, posters and many more items that have been preserved by Gene and Paul, and which give us a chance to share a piece of KISS history beyond our most vivid memories.

Each sale made pursuant to these Conditions of Sale will be deemed to constitute a grant of a security interest by the purchaser to us in, and we may retain as collateral security for the purchaser's obligations to us, any of the purchaser's property in our possession, and we may apply against such obligations all monies held or received by us for the account of, or owing to, the purchaser. Whenever the purchaser pays only a part of the total purchase price for one or more lots purchased, we may apply such payments, in our sole discretion, to the lot or lots we choose. Payment will not be deemed made in full until we have collected all amounts due in cash or good funds represented by cleared checks or cashier checks. If the foregoing conditions or any other applicable conditions herein are not complied with, in addition to other remedies available to us and the consignor by law, including but without limitation, the right to hold the purchaser liable for the purchase price, we at our option may either (a) cancel the sale, retaining as liquidated damages all payments made by the purchaser or (b) resell the property, either publicly or privately, and in such event the purchaser shall be liable for the payment of any deficiency plus all costs and expenses of both sales, our commission at our standard rates, all other charges due hereunder, attorney's fees and incidental damages. All fees, commissions, premiums, bid price and other sums due to us from the purchaser and not paid promptly as provided in this paragraph 2, shall bear interest at 11/2% per month from the fourth day following the sale to the date payment is received.

LIMITED RIGHT OF RESCISSION: If within a reasonable time (which in no event shall exceed six months) of the date of sale of any lot, the original purchaser (a) gives notice in writing to us alleging that the identification of Authorship (as defined below) of such lot as set forth in the BOLD TYPE heading of the catalogue description of such lot (as amended by any posted notices or verbal announcements during the sale) is not substantially correct based on a fair reading of the catalogue (including the terms of any glossary contained therein), and (b) within 10 days after such notice returns the lot to us in the same condition as at the time of sale and (c) establishes the allegation in the notice to our satisfaction, then the sale of such lot will be rescinded and, unless we have already paid to the consignor monies owed him in connection with the sale, the original purchase price will be refunded. THE PURCHASER EXPRESSLY ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL WE BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY COMPENSATORY, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

- "Authorship" means only the identity of the creator, the period, culture and source or origin of the lot, as the case may be, as set forth in the BOLD TME heading of a catalogue entry. The right of rescission does not extend to (a) works executed before 1870 unless these works are determined to be counterfeit, as this is a matter of current scholarly opinion which can change. (b) titles or other identification of offered lots or descriptions of physical condition and size, quality, rarity, importance, provenance, exhibition and literature of historical relevance, which information normally appears in lower case type below the BOLD TME heading identifying the Authorship.

Estimates

Butterfields catalogues include estimates for each lot. The estimates in the catalogues are provided as an approximate guide to current market value, and should not be interpreted as a price. Estimates are determined at the time a piece is consigned, which is well in advance of the sale and therefore subject to revision without notice. Please do not hesitate to contact the specialist in charge if you should have any questions.

Bidding at Auction

Bidding takes place with numbered bid cards, held up so that the auctioneer can clearly see them. Bidding normally begins at about one-third to one-half the estimate, but the final bid price may well be less than or more than any estimate printed.
